Father Nigel Mumford is director of the Healing Ministry at Christ the King Spiritual Life Center, Greenwich, NY. The ministry has approximately 30 volunteer trained prayer team members. Born and educated in England, he served for six and a half years in Her Majesty's Royal Marines, assigned to Northern Ireland. His last two years were as a drill instructor at the Commando Training School.

His conviction to pray for healing came in 1989 when his sister, Julie Sheldon, a ballet dancer with the Royal Ballet in London, was healed by God through the late Canon Jim Glennon. This was a very dramatic healing from a disease called Dystonia, a neurological condition that curled her into a fetal position and left her very close to death. Being a witness to her healing has had a profound effect on his life.

Father Mumford graduated from Episcopal Training, "The Ministry Exploration and Education Program" (MEEP) in June, 1995, as a lay minister and was formally installed as the director of The Oratory of the Little Way by the Episcopal Bishop of Connecticut in 1997. He was ordained an Episcopal priest with the Episcopal diocese of Albany on Dec 17<sup>th</sup> 2005 .

His publications: Hand to Hand: From Combat to Healing (Church Publishing Inc), The Forgotten Touch (Seabury Press), Heartfelt Prayers For Healing, Thirty One Day Devotional, The Practice of Soaking Prayer, & A Prescription for Healing (The Oratory Press). A prayer by Fr. Nigel was published in Race and Prayer (Morehouse Publishing Inc).

Father Nigel is a speaker for The International Order of Saint Luke the Physician. The ministry has been written up by the New York Times and two stories of healing have been published in Guidposts Magazine. He regularly contributes to the Order of St.. Luke bi-monthly Sharing Magazine. He has been the keynote speaker for the North American OSL, (www.orderofstluke.org), and ACTS - Associations of Christian Therapists, has spoken at the Universities of Cornell, NY, Hobart and William

Smith, NY, Hamilton College, NY, and at Gordon College, MA.

In 2008, a new program was created at the Healing Ministry, "The Welcome Home Initiative" led by Fr. Mumford, and two other retired military men, Bishop David Bena, and Lt. Col. Noel Dawes. This three day retreat invites men, women and families of our Armed Forces from all wars who have served in combat, to come "free of charge" and be "welcomed home" a program providing ministry and resources for health and healing.

In 2009, he was hospitalized with H1N1. He was in a chemical induced coma for 19 days, after being put on a ventilator and given a tracheostomy. After six weeks in ICU and three more at a rehab facility, he was sent home on Dec. 23, 2009 to continue his recovery. A year later, he returned to traveling around the world, teaching and preaching the healing ministry of Jesus Christ. Father Nigel gives thanks and praise to all the intercessors' prayer; he is alive because of prayer.

Outside the ministry, Fr. Mumford enjoys sailing, boating, gardening, writing, public speaking, biking, and playing the violin, bagpipes, clarinet & trumpet. He lives with his wife Lynn in Greenwich, near Saratoga Springs, New York.
